How might you replicate sounds, smells, tastes? With pictures of the things that are creating them? Or more subtly, with shapes and colours that might evoke them? Think outside the box	experimenting with technique. Your chosen materials for the finished piece - don't be in a hurry to decide on this. Low-relief and even pop-ups could be used, in which case you may need scissors, glue and suitable card or paper
Week 6, 11th December	Catching up and Finishing Off A chance to catch up with any sessions that you missed and to complete any unfinished work	Unfinished work and appropriate materials to continue with it.
