



Creative Art Workshops

Tuesdays, September/October 25

Classes will run Tuesdays, 1-3 pm and are held at All Saints Church Hall, Brough St West, SK11 8EL. Date	Topic	You will need:
Week 1, 16th September	<i>Taking a line for a walk – experiments in line drawing</i> We will be exploring mark making to create drawings of faces.	Biros or gel pens, preferably black; sketchbooks or loose paper; I will supply images of faces
Week 2, 23rd September	<i>Colouring the Seasons - an exploration of colour mixing</i> We will experiment with colour mixing to create a palette for each of the four seasons	Sketchbooks or loose paper; paints - these can be watercolour, or acrylics, with suitable brushes; water pots and mixing palettes
Week 3, 30th September	<i>Colouring the Seasons - an exploration of colour mixing</i> Using the colours we made last week we will create a landscape for a chosen season	As above. Landscape images appropriate for your chosen season, e.g. spring flowers, a beach scene, autumn trees, a snow scene. I can supply if necessary!

Date	Topic	You will need:
Week 4 , 7th October Week 5 , 14th October	<i>Mixed media collages</i> Using our colour experiments from week 2, as well as other found papers we will create abstract collages from cut and torn paper	Colour mixing experiments from week 2. Found papers - magazines, gift wrap, book pages etc. Glue (I recommend flour and water paste!) Glue spreaders. Cartridge paper to stick things onto; flimsy plastic bags for pressing things down; old magazine to act as gluing surface; <i>Optional:</i> scissors; rollers, fancy scissors; cutting mat and craft knife
Week 6 , 21st October	<i>Catching up and Finishing Off!</i> Completion of any unfinished work. Catching up with any missed sessions	As appropriate from previous sessions

There will be a further 6-week block of sessions on Tuesday afternoons from 6 January to 10 February 2026
