



## Creative Art Workshop Spring Term 2026

DATE	TOPIC	YOU WILL NEED
<b>Week 1</b> , January 6th	<b>Continuous line drawings</b> - animals	Pen; sketchbooks or loose paper; I will supply images of animals, or you are free to bring your own if you prefer
<b>Week 2</b> , January 13th	<b>Dendritic Printing</b>	2 sheets of glass or perspex (not acetate, as it needs to be fairly rigid) up to A4 in size. Loose paper - needs to be smooth. You can bring coloured or printed paper, as well as white; acrylic paints; palette knives; plastic sheets to separate prints for getting them home
<b>Weeks 3 &amp; 4</b> , January 20th and 27th	<b>Portrait Studies</b> either use half a full-face photograph and complete the other half or use a full-page photograph of the back of your(or someone else's) head	A full-page photograph to work from. This can be one you've taken, or one from a magazine; colour media - this can be paint, pastel, pencils or whatever you choose (collage????)
<b>Week 5</b> , February 3rd	<b>...scape</b> Using dendritic prints from week 2 as a starting point, you will create a landscape, seascape or cityscape. This may be entirely collaged, or you might just use the prints as background to build on.	Dendritic prints from week 2; glue; background paper, sturdy enough to glue on to; scissors; photographs to work from
<b>Week 6</b> , February 10th	<b>Catching up and Finishing Off!</b> Completion of any unfinished work. Catching up with any missed sessions	Any unfinished work, and appropriate materials
